



AATCC Foundation/ Institute of Textile Technology Undergraduate Research Program

The Institute of Textile Technology (ITT) and the AATCC Foundation have developed a new grant program for undergraduate students.

ITT will fund up to **five (5) US\$2,000 undergraduate awards** each year for research in textile engineering and chemistry, polymer science, or materials science through the AATCC Foundation/ITT Undergraduate Student Research Support Program.

US college juniors should submit proposals, plus supporting documentation, for work on one of the areas of interest defined by ITT. The US\$2,000 will be given directly to the student and if an outstanding proposal is presented, an even higher level of funding may be awarded. Half of the award will be given in the spring semester of the student's junior year, and half will be given when the final research report is submitted at the end of the fall semester of the student's senior year.

Proposals to be funded will be selected by ITT faculty and member representatives, and approved by the AATCC Foundation Board of Directors.

All award recipients will have the opportunity to present their research at ITT's Spring Meeting during the students' senior year. At the meeting, students can interact with the CEOs and researchers of leading global textile companies. ITT will pay all travel expenses to the Spring Meeting for two students selected based on the quality of the research findings. Other students must pay their own travel expenses.
