Publications cover the apparel, home furnishings, flooring, and polymer industries. *Textile Technology Complete* includes literature on manufacturing techniques; textile end products; chemicals and dyes; properties of natural and synthetic fibers and yarns; textile-related environmental issues; and textile-related areas of chemistry, biology, and physics.

Advanced search functions will enable AATCC members to find the most recent *Women's Wear Daily* interview with Giorgio Armani, or the news about the carpet industry's sustainability standard from *Floor Covering Weekly*—from the latest in denim fashions, to the technical abrasion properties of upholstery, the breadth and depth of the textile and related industries is well-represented. The database is also a great resource for scholars; publications included in this collection are from all over the world and include major textile-and-polymer-related scientific journals.
