Authors of accepted oral presentation papers will be notified. In accepting an invitation to present a paper at the conference, a speaker agrees to provide AATCC with the full text or PowerPoint presentation by February 6, 2017. Speakers receive complimentary registration for the conference.

Abstracts for poster presentations should clearly state the problem, solution, and results of the research work. Poster abstracts will be accepted until November 11, 2016 and should be submitted to Peggy J. Pickett at pickettp@aatcc.org. Poster presenters pay a reduced conference fee.

The program will also feature the traditional Herman and Myrtle Goldstein Student Paper Competition and the Olney Medal Address.
