AATCC and Runway of Dreams Foundation Announce the 2020 “Fashion for All” Student Design Competition

The 2020 theme challenges students to transform a current stylish, on-trend look that reimagines fashion and function for persons with dwarfism.

[Runway of Dreams Foundation](#) will award a minimum of US\$5,000 scholarship to the first-place winner. The award will be given at Runway of Dreams Annual Fashion Revolution Gala and Fashion Show in NYC in September 2020.
